I believe God gave me some pretty direct instructions before the retreat, for example, the subject matter of the retreat, "Finding God's Favor." I have always been enthralled by Ester's story but I seemed to find myself consumed with sharing the truths within the book. After all, my main passion is to share with everyone God's desire to have an intimate relationship with Him. Esther learned what pleased the king and acted on it! He kept impressing me to find worship dancers so I inquired about those I knew who danced. Everyone had a conflict and could not come. It seemed everywhere I went I saw something about dancing for Him but up until the day of the retreat we did not have a dancer.

Helen, who came to provide music, shared with me that God had instructed her to do a dance worship segment as we worshiped. I just rejoiced. Now I knew that the plan to have the ladies make dance ribbons was all in God's plan. He amazes me!

After communion, we planned to watch the video with Tammy's teaching. We had difficulties hearing the video and after attempting it several times I felt the Lord saying He didn't want us to do it that night. The young mans picture is Jason Dunlap who recently was release and came to help us with chores around the office. Please continue to pray for him to find a job and transportation.


## **Comments from the Retreat**
