On July 15 and July 17, we were honored to be a part of Community Serve. We were overwhelmed by the volunteers who came to put together over 100 shoeboxes for our out-reach to prisoners' kids. They also made over 300 salvation bracelets, put together two large tubs of inmate hygiene packets and brought books to take to the Forsyth Detention Center.

I was reminded of Henry Blackaby's words: "One mark of revival, during which God comes to His people in power, is that God's people are compelled to offer their lives for His service. What we need is not more pleas for volunteers, but an outpouring of the power of God. When God comes among the

people in power, there is never a shortage of volunteers or resources for His work!"



Spirit, listen to the Word of God and be blessed with the passionate cry of the psalmist in Psalm 63:1 “ O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you.” And in Psalm 42:1 “As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, O God.”

Spirit, be blessed to live from that deep cry of seeking God in your innermost being, longing for more of Him, digging in to know Him more intimately.
