Many times people have said, "I am sure that many of the ones who get your newsletters and Bible Studies just toss them in the trash or choose not to read them, so why do you bother?" I have mulled that issue over in my mind knowing that not all the recipients do read or take advantage of the material we supply. In my time away God took me to a parable I needed to be reminded of in Matthew 13 about the seed.

The seeds falling on the road represent those who hear the word, but dismiss it straight way. In Mark's gospel he says Satan takes the Word away.

The seeds falling on the rocks represent those who hear the Word, but only accept it shallowly. The synoptic state that these sorts of people reject the Word as soon as it causes them affliction and persecution.

The seeds falling on thorns represent those who hear the Word, and take it to heart, but allow worldly concerns, such as money and cares of this world to choke it.

The seeds falling on good soil represents those who hear the Word, and truly receive it spiritually causing it to bear fruit.

On the way to the beach, I noticed a garden shop by the name of, Seed Slinger. I loved it because I believe that is what God has On Wings doing, slinging seeds, the seed of His Word. Some of it falls on hard soil or rocks and never takes root, some lands among the weeds and is eventually overtaken and choked out, but some falls on well tilled, fertile soil and produces a harvest. It is not for us as seed slingers to question where the seed falls

but that we are being obedient to the Lord in sowing the seed. The wind of His Holy Spirit will take it and plant it right where it needs to be.

I am reminded of the passages in 1 Corinthians 3:6-7, "I planted the seed and Apollos watered it, but God made it grow. So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and they will each be rewarded according to their own labor".



So my question to you is: Where is the seed falling in your life, on hard or fertile ground? If it has fallen on the

road and not really taken root in your life why don't you repent of that and allow the Sower to implant it deep in your heart today. He tells us if we seek after Him He will be found. You have the opportunity to grow in your spiritual journey as you allow Him to speak to you through the newsletter and the Bible Study that is provided, but it's a choice.

Then YOU be a seed slinger by sharing with those you come in contact with the truth of God's Word. You can sow His Word. Even if others don't readily receive the seed they may come to a point that they will remember when you shared with them. Happy sowing!
