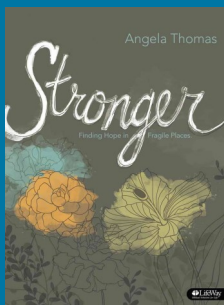

Most of our readers are very familiar with the drug crisis in our country because of their own personal struggle with the disease. Recently there are more & more reports of addiction due to the increase of opioid and heroin overdoses being reported. Statistics say that in Forsyth County alone opioid related deaths increased from 13 in 2005 to 53 in 2015, a four fold increase.

This is a quote from the Winston-Salem Journal: "During 2016, emergency departments in North Carolina treated more than 4,100 opioid overdoses, an average of 11 per day. The State Center for Health Statistics reported that in 2015, commonly prescribed opioid medications were involved in more than 500 deaths."

So I'd say our nation, not just our county has a crisis. This problem is widespread and growing in our midst and it is no respecter of people. Its not just a certain economic status or people group. It just may touch someone you know someone at your job, someone your child knows— your child, your spouse— then it becomes real and personal.

At that point, we'll begin to ask questions like; How did this happen? How did I not see the signs? What did I do or what could I have done? Why can't they quit? So how does addiction happen?

Many start on "innocent" pain killers after surgery or for chronic pain. These opioid medications lead to heroin addiction. Almost

13,000 people died from heroin overdoses in 2015. Do you think we have a problem?

In our experience we have seen the drugs so many people want to legalize— marijuana — lead to harder drugs like cocaine and meth. Marijuana is just a doorway for searching for greater high or thrill. We will never be in agreement with its legalization. If Satan gets a stronghold through these substances, he will use it to kill, steal, and destroy families & individuals. We see it happening daily.

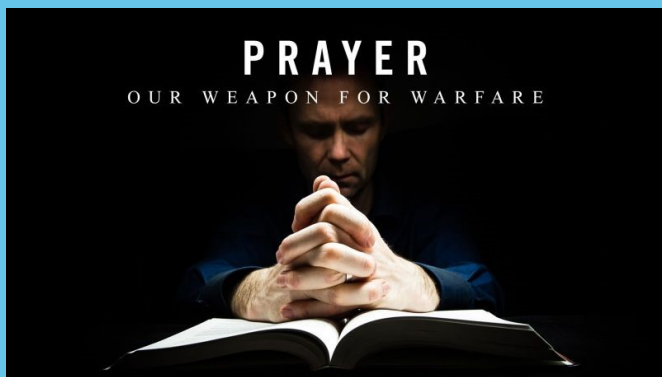
So how can we combat this monster that is bringing destruction on families and our country. We need to educate, rehabilitate, and support our families bringing encouragement and hope. I dedicate my mind to the control of the Lord. Bind up all wicked spirits coming against my emotions, on the conscious, subconscious, and unconscious levels. Take control of my emotions, and fill me with the fruit of the Spirit. Bind up all wicked spirits trying to control my will, on the conscious, subconscious, and unconscious levels. Purify and set apart my will to the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Bind up all wicked spirits coming against all parts of my physical body. Set free, cleanse, and sanctify my body for Your use and Your glory. Dispatch ministering spirits of God to go forth in Jesus' mighty name and give me all necessary help. Thank You for my complete freedom in my Lord Jesus Christ. I rest in Your sure presence. In Jesus' name, Amen."
