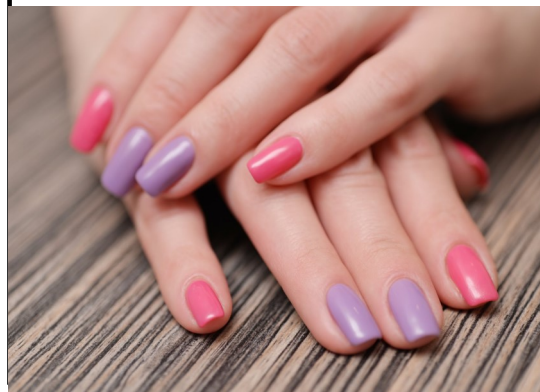

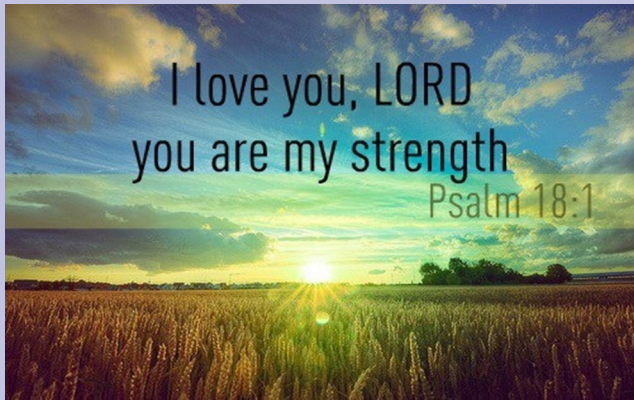
Ladies Bible Study
