Tetelestai

I know you are thinking what in the world is that word, tetelestai! It means "It is Finished". Those were the last words spoken by Jesus from the cross. He said, "It is Finished"; all of our sins have been paid for in full. In Greek it means to bring to a close, to complete, to fulfill. Our debt is paid, we have been ransomed from the kingdom of darkness if we have accepted Him as Lord in our lives. Now that is something to celebrate.

Recently, my friend and I were at the mall and at one of the little booths there was a man selling all kinds of signs with scripture and Christian sayings on them. We were drawn to the bracelets of all colors with the word tetelestai imprinted on them. I remember the pronunciation by: to tell a lie....but it's "to tell astai"! Maybe that will help you remember, but of course the message is no lie! I am now wearing one of those bracelets in hopes it will open conversation to allow me to share with those who need to hear His message of hope.

This is the month we are taken back to the scene of Christ's death on a cruel cross but more importantly the celebration of His resurrection. The tomb is empty and He now sits at the Father's right-hand interceding for us. What a picture, what a promise.

Each year the Moravians have a Sunrise Service where thousands flock to the Easter sunrise service to celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is held in the middle of the cemetery where all those in Christ will rise from their graves to meet Him in the air one day, (we believe soon and very soon). What a privilege we have to be in this location.

Our office at On Wings is right beside a historic graveyard in Old Salem. The burial site named God's Acre is 40 acres in size and the first Moravian settler was buried there in 1771. My family has a religious heritage of being Moravians. My great, great grandmother is buried on the hill within sight of our office and my great grandparents are buried down the hill in another section. I love to walk through there and read the tombstones and see the marvelous monuments placed on some of the graves from way back in the 1800's.

Let me challenge you to read Matthew 27:32-56 about the crucifixion of Jesus. If you have Him in your heart just take the time to meditate on His sacrifice for all and thank Him in remembrance of the sin that He took on Himself for us to have the promise of eternal life to come. If you have never surrendered your life to Him, please take this time to invite Him into your heart and life right now. If you make that decision, let us know.

We hope you have your own tradition for celebrating Christ's resurrection. We will be giving Easter baskets to our local prison for distribution to the children of the inmates. We always put materials in the baskets that explain the real reason for the season. Pray for these children to know God's love for them .

Sinking Into Grace

"Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the guards stand watch in vain." Psalm 127:1-2
