Jabez Prayer

"And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, "oh, that you would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!" So, God granted him what he requested."

I Chronicles 4:10

A few years ago, the On Wings board members were led to pray the Jabez Prayer. God has certainly blessed us and enlarged our territory over the years. God took me back to that passage this year and our words for the year are, Lord, Bless us indeed so we can bless others.

We are asking the Lord to show us new opportunities this year that we can bless others while expanding His kingdom for His glory. We are watching to see where He is working so we can join Him as He reveals His vision. Jabez left it entirely up to God to decide what the blessings would be and where, when, and how He would receive them. We want to do God's will, in God's way, and in His timing.

What we know from Deuteronomy 28:2 is this: "All these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the Lord your God."! Obedience is the key. We can't be living a life opposed to the Word of God and expect His Blessings. In Deuteronomy 28:1-14, the last half of the chapter states if you don't listen to the Lord God and obey His laws then curses will come upon you. We certainly don't want to experience the curses. We are asking the Lord to bless us but it's clear His blessings are contingent on our obedience and it's our desire to be obedient to His every direction.

Today, I received a call from a friend who had been in prison and was blessed by a Bible from us in 2020. He is now home and desires to spread God's word in his own community. He asked that we join him to send God's word into his local jail. We consider it a privilege to send Bibles into this facility and as the friend requested, we will pass God's blessings to On Wings into this community by supplying Bibles.

We are seeing God answer our prayer for His blessing, then blessing others, and He is expanding our territory for His glory and providing spiritual growth in the lives of those who receive the Bible. I love it that God blessed this young man and that he is now flipping the blessing to those on the inside. It is really true: you cannot out give God.

Maybe you can flip a blessing to someone today in response to God's generosity to you. It truly is more blessed to give than to receive. Begin making it a routine in your life today if you haven't done so before. Look for ways to bless others.

What's in your hand that you can bless another person with this year? Ponder these words and ask the Father to give you opportunities.
